





My success & struggle story..


I never dream to become a tarotreader or an Astrologer but destiny made me to choose this divine science.

invited to join the New Frontier Incubation Program at the Sundance Film Festival in 2023. But what was it that made her give up her cherished position and move out into unexplored turf on her own. "I had seen this new concept of immersive theatre – which allowed the audience to be engaged with the story, share experiences in the form of food, music, settings, conversations with the cast, and even contribute their own story line and interpretations to the show. I wanted to explore it further and present the same experience to Indian audiences." With a full time job, it was difficult, but she still managed to find time to develop her own version of 'A Mad Tea-Party' based on the characters and settings of Lewis Carrol's timeless classic 'Alice in Wonderland'. "I wanted to create the setting, and mad-cap characters and for that, a traditional theatre setting would not do." So, she went around the Mumbai suburbs looking for an ideal locale and finally homed in on an old bakery in Bandra. In this space, she created the tunnel which Alice goes through, the different characters and finally the tea-party itself – an experience where, at the end of the play, the audience joined the tea party with the characters. "I brought together a group of artists to create what we called 'an artists' rendition of Wonderland'. Every artist brought in their work to showcase and we curated a two-hour unique immersive experience, for an audience to

experience the space, the artists' works, some theatre and of course, food and drinks. The

ARTNOWTHUS – TRANSFORMING THE CULTURAL LANDSCAPE

When Ragini Singh Khushwaha decided to leave her role as the Executive Director of a prestigious Theatre School in Mumbai, it was a decision that took many by surprise. But as she herself puts it, "Though my work in academic pedagogy and executive management was very rewarding, I wanted to be able to create my own work, and bring the experience of immersive theatre which I had seen during my studies in London, to the audiences here in India." And so began ArtNowThus – a play on the Hindi words for 8,9,10 – a unique media company that creates and curates; stories and experiences with the aim to help explore culture past, present and future – better.

Ragini is uniquely positioned to help develop this concept. She has a Masters degree in Performance Making from the prestigious Goldsmiths College, University of London - something that first exposed her to the different nuances of theatre. She has served as the youngest Executive Director of the Drama School Mumbai until 2020, leading it into its digital pivot. She was one of the 15 fellows for the ARThink South Asia's Fellowship for Future Leaders in Arts and Culture - a yearlong program in London in 2017. As an artist, she has collaborated with performers on national and international projects. Her interdisciplinary performance piece titled 'Don't f*** with my Unicorn' was performed in London and was selected as a shortlist finalist for the Annual Rich Mix festival. Most recently, Ragini has been



first show played out in June 2019, sold out throughout its run and was an incredible success. ArtNowThus had arrived.

ArtNowThus produced a second show in the same year 'My Fair Ladle' and ran it to the same success as their first. This story took you into an old family home, where a family of diverse characters plot and scheme, thrust and parry, as old secrets about the house and the characters emerge – all seen through the eyes of a ghost. Then as the family decide to sit down for a final traditional dinner – the audience joins them at the table. The result is a fascinating culinary and theatrical experience, involving food, music, theatre, that makes the viewer a part of the setting and the story itself. Again, Ragini forsook the traditional stage, choosing instead to perform in restaurant spaces around Mumbai – and again with the same results.

The Audience sharing the Immersive Theatre Experience

The concept of immersive theatre which she had been propagating was just gathering steam, when the pandemic struck in 2020. "We were in the midst of looking for more show venues when everything closed down. The ensuing lockdowns meant our particular format of experiences had to be set aside. It was during this time, over the last two years that I built out our content vertical. We started with a homegrown podcast called Barely Researched Facts, that has just completed its second season. We also launched the newsletter Probably Relevant - a bimonthly newsletter that covers everything that's relevant and cool in the world of culture. From features on some truly phenomenal entrepreneurs to community recommendations, to articles on pop culture and cinema and art and even personal finance - we cover everything. It's a one stop shop that makes any reader the most interesting person in any room!"You can check out the latest issue of Probably Relevant here.

As ArtNowThus gathers momentum, Ragini is in the process of expanding the concept. "We're currently in the process of bringing back our madly popular show 'A Mad Tea-Party', which we're very excited for. We're also producing a new science podcast and working on a brand-new content collaboration with our newsletter, hopefully letting us bring the newsletter to our readers thrice a month instead of just twice now." The opening up of pandemic restrictions will also enable her to conduct the wildly successful shows, in different parts of the country and bring out the concept of immersive theatre in the fields of training and development – something that will enable audiences to learn by the timeless art of storytelling.

Dr. Neeru Bhatt was born on 25th June 1971 in Bhimtal, Uttarakhand. She has always had a passion for reading and writing. She received a merit grant from the UP Board of Education from sixth grade till tenth grade. After completing her school, she enrolled in G B Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar, Uttarakhand, where she earned her bachelor's and master's degrees. She graduated with a Ph.D. in Animal Nutrition (major) and Food Science (minor) from the same institution. Her doctorate work was based on herbal products and was supported by Dabur Ayurvet. For her master's and doctorate degrees, she was awarded fellowships by the Jan Sewa Trust and the institution, respectively. She cleared National Eligibility Test for Assistant Professorship and Lectureship as well. She has also done Postgraduate Diploma in Intellectual Property Rights from Indira Gandhi National Open University New Delhi and a few short courses from World Intellectual Property Organization Academy, Geneva, Switzerland.

Dr. Neeru Bhatt began her professional career at the Indian Veterinary Research Institute Izzatnager, Uttar Pradesh, a pioneer institute in veterinary research. In the year 2005, she moved to Oman. She was employed by Oman Flour Mills, SAOG, a market leader in the nation's livestock feed and flour industries. Later she joined the Food Science and Nutrition department of Sultan Qaboos University Al Khoud, Oman, and worked there for approximately twelve years in various capacities.

Dr. Neeru Bhatt is a life member of several scientific societies and member of the editorial board and a reviewer of other high-ranked journals. She is the Managing Editor of the Canadian Journal of Clinical Nutrition. She has authored/co-authored more than twenty-five peer-reviewed scientific papers and has a high number of citations in scientific metrics. She has also authored one book entitled Neglected wild flora of Uttarakhand, published by Notion Publication Chennai. Her work has been featured in Sahitya Kunj (a web magazine publishes in Canada), Rajasthan Patrika, Amar Ujala Kavay Kosh and Poetry soup. I and My Womanhood (Ms. Meena Patel)

I am 60 years old. In all these years I have stumbled, fallen, done things which I feel I could have done differently / better, things I am not very proud of today, berated, psychologically cornered into a black space and have been called names. Most times because of my Gender. This continues in some form or another. But I have never failed to stand up and march on. At times on my own, at times with a hand from my better half, at times with a shoulder from our daughter, sometimes with solidarity from my sorority sisters and at times with handholding from family. Standing tall, strong, empowered and with pride is a constant. For I am a woman born free, with dignity and pride. This universe, my own inner self, and legal parameters world over (however backward but evolving and changing) grant me this right. I am proud and am certain, that my Ba did not birth me to be abused, for someone else to break my knees and backbone so that I may stoop for somebody to conquer over me. I will fight fiercely with my head and shoulder held high and strong. After all, it is a matter

of dignity and birth right of all women on this universe. We, women, make this universe whole.

Growing up, I was convinced that all us women were born empowered. On the way, I learnt, it was not so. Or else how does one explain these news reports we come across regularly?

February 2023: Members of the Thakor Community in Gujarat Palanpur issue an unanimous diktat passed by the elders, banning teenage girls from their community using cell phones. According to a community elder and leader, Ms. Ganiben Thakor, democratically elected MLA from Banskantha, "...unmarried daughters should stay away from technology and spend more time on studying..." the obvious having left unspoken.

October 2022: In Hardoi, Uttar Pradesh, a woman was stabbed repeatedly by her husband while she was praying for his long life on Karwa Chauth (a festival religiously followed by women pan India by fasting without food and water till they spot the moon and worship it through a sieve with the husband standing in front of her). Why? If he did not want a long life, he just had to spare her the hunger-day.

About Ms. Meena Patel:




though, went to market and I said retailer to give a nozzle forcake.




